Recommended Packing List for the 2023 Season

For the Fieldwork

<input type="checkbox"/>	Pants or Shorts. Bring those pants or shorts you wouldn't mind getting dirty.
<input type="checkbox"/>	T-Shirts. We recommend lightweight fabrics, easy to wash (at least 5 or 6). Some folks like tank tops, others long sleeves—it's up to you!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Closed Shoes. Closed-toed shoes are required for working on-site.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lightweight Jacket or Sweatshirt. For chilly mornings and survey hours.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hat. Sun protection is a must.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sunscreen. It is essential (recommended are SPF 30+).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sunglasses. Cool and practical.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Water Bottle. It will get very hot.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Notebook and Writing Material. For documentation, lecture notes, and memories.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Backpack. A small bag or backpack to bring to the site. It will get dirty.

Extras

<input type="checkbox"/>	Gloves or Kneepads. You can bring your own gloves or kneepads if you want to use them.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Tissues, Sanitizer, or Baby Wipes. Some people like to have baby wipes/tissues/sanitizer on site with them.

After/Before the Fieldwork

<input type="checkbox"/>	Comfy Clothes and Sandals. Comfy things to wear after working on the tel. There is pottery washing and other things in the afternoon where you might get a bit dusty. If you plan to visit religious sites (e.g., some places in Nazareth or Jerusalem), ensure that you have appropriately modest clothing.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Towels. Preferably two towels: one for showering and one for the pool.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Swimsuit.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hygiene Items. Toiletries, over-the-counter meds, period products, and other hygiene items are readily available all over Israel and at the small grocery shop on the kibbutz, but perhaps not always the brands you might like.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Alarm clock, Phone Alarm, or Watch Alarm. You must wake up on time.
